### G Harmonic Minor

First measure: G4 (open), A4 (0), B4 (1), C5 (3).  
 Second measure: D5 (0), E5 (1), F#5 (4), G5 (0).

Third measure: A4 (4), B4 (1), C5 (0), D5 (3).  
 Fourth measure: E5 (1), F#5 (0), G5 (3).
